**"Sunday Mornin' Country®"** is the longest running Country Gospel concert, held each year during what began as Fan Fair, now called CMA Music Fest. Since that time, the best of Country and Gospel artists continue to come together, offering their time and talents keeping this legacy alive. Sunday Mornin' Country® is produced by the Music City Christian Fellowship, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization created in 1980 by those first artists. The group remains strong with members across the nation and internationally, committed to the mission of "Taking the Gospel of Jesus Christ across the world through His gift, the international language of music."

Thankful for how God has blessed the Fellowship and Sunday Mornin' Country®, the Board of Directors felt led to seek out ways to share these blessings with others.
